SUBJECT: UPDATE ON REFORM PROPOSALS

With reference to letter F.No.1(01)-ST/BOI/24(RG) dated, 22nd April 2025 implementation status of the mentioned reforms is as following.

1. **Implement unique QR codes on seed certificates issued:** It is submitted that more advanced feature of verification and traceability is implemented in the form of system generated unique random code on each tag. The Main aim behind all this is to establish a system of traceability and verify the authenticity of seed bags distributed in the market. These random unique codes are easy to read and can also be verified through SMS on "8662". As most of the farmers in the rural community still don't have android mobiles to scan the QR codes but they are able to verify through SMS. However, option of online verification through web portal is also available for progressive growers. Certified Tag representing the system generated unique random code is given as [Annex-1](#).
2. **Implement an appeal mechanism for seed registration rejections to avoid resubmission:** It is to inform that FSC&RD has developed the online portal for Seed Company Registration with the aim to address the resubmissions due to rejections. In case of any deficiency or shortcomings in the submitted documents, application is returned to the applicant for fulfillment of the deficiencies only. After receiving the deficit documents, complete case is processed for further approval. So, the process of application submission and processing is more flexible and user friendly along with feature of avoiding the resubmission of whole application from beginning. Seed Company Registration module with these features was demonstrated to the team of BOI on Regulatory Reforms, and they appreciated the developed module.
